- c. <u>AtlaSerials, Religion Collection</u> (choose from list): full-text records and citations from 350+ journals, both PDFs and searchable text of articles and reviews in all fields of religion and theology

- h. <u>Johannine Studies</u>: covers John's Gospel, Epistles, and Revelation, does not include New Testament commentaries listed above
- i. Parables: eBooks, articles and essays, does not include New Testament commentaries listed above
- j. Pauline Studies: eBooks on Paul's writings, does not include New Testament commentaries listed above
- k. Paul and Patristics: comprehensive database of Pauline references in pre-Nicene writings
- 1. Oxford Handbooks Online: 3,000+ articles related to the New Testament reviewing key issues and debates
- m. <u>DTL Deuterocanon/Apocrypha</u>: commentaries in the DTL by book and general works on the Apocrypha
- n. <u>Greco-Roman Religions</u>: journals, and eBooks on the world of 2nd Temple Judaism and Early Christianity; use the DTL advanced search for additional resources

- o. <u>DTL Dead Sea Scrolls</u>: important reference works, journals, digital databases, and transcriptions of the scrolls
- p. <u>Loeb Digital Classical Library</u>: entire collection of Harvard Press' Loeb Classical Library of most important works of classical literature available in bilingual (Greek-English or Latin-English); constantly updated, helpful in understanding the Greco-Roman world during 2nd Temple Judaism and the rise of Christianity.
- q. New Testament Backgrounds
 - i. <u>Database of Military Inscriptions and Papyri of Early Roman Palestine</u>: Jewish soldiers, Palestinian soldiers, military religion, the Herodian dynasty, the Jewish War (66-73 CE), and more
 - Institute for the Study of the Ancient World from New York University: maps, documents, images from the Roman Empire, very useful for advanced study of the New Testament and Christian origins.
 - iii. <u>Center for Hellenic Studies (Harvard)</u>: books, articles, translations of major works providing classical backgrounds of the New Testament
 - iv. <u>Bryn Mawr Classical Review</u>: open access, peer-reviewed reviews of current scholarly work in the field of classical studies including archaeology from 1990 to the present
 - v. BAS Library: 7,000+ full-text articles and 22,000 captioned images related to Biblical archeology
 - vi. <u>Society of Biblical Literature Bible Odyssey</u>: latest historical and literary research on key people, places, and passages of the Bible

- b. ProQuest Academic Complete in DTL: eBooks including many on the New Testament
