Fellowship Denver internships are designed to train and equip individuals who are pursuing local church ministry in order to multiply kingdom impact. We desire to carry on the same work exemplified in Paul's training of Timothy by helping interns, "to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands, for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control" (2 Timothy 1:6-7). All internships are one year long, beginning in August 2021 and concluding in July 2022.

An internship integrates knowledge and theory with practical application and skills development. Fellowship Denver offers internships to provide experiential ministry learning via a clear training track, personal supervision, discipleship, mentoring, and real-time church work hours and leadership opportunities. We are seeking internship applicants who have a personal relationship with God, a love for local church ministry, and a desire to gain practical ministry experience within Worship & Arts Ministry.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attend required weekly Intern Core Track training (Wednesdays 8:00-10:00 am)
- Meet weekly with Ministry Supervisor, the Pastor of Worship & Arts Ministry
- Attend weekly Staff Meeting (Tuesdays 8:30-10:30 am)
- Serve on Sunday mornings to support the work of Worship & Arts Ministries
- Spend required vocational ministry work hours as directed by Ministry Supervisor which may include:
 - Writing liturgical pieces for Sunday services
 - Serve in a band and lead worship for Sunday services
 - Run general ministry related errands
 - Assist with the upkeep of the art gallery, including show openings and closings
 - Assist with planning and execution of W&A programs and events
 - Assist with and participate in volunteer discipleship and investment
 - Assist with and participate in volunteer scheduling

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
