- 15 *“Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali,
the Way of the Sea, beyond the Jordan,
Galilee of the Gentiles—*
- 16 *the people living in darkness
have seen a great light;
on those living in the land
of the shadow of death
a light has dawned.”*

*17 From that time on Jesus began to preach,
“Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come
near.” —Matthew 4:13-17*

JOURNEY TO THE LAND OF THE BIBLE

Denver Seminary would like to invite you on a journey that will change the way you read the Bible and worship our Lord. December 3-14, 2019 we will visit the place where most of the stories of the Bible occurred, the land of Israel. Throughout our time together we will get to see, hear, and feel the geography and countryside that framed the life of Jesus and the apostles.

The Bible will come to life as we visit sites such as Capernaum, in Jesus' day a bustling fishing village on the Sea of Galilee situated on an ancient route that ran from Syria to Egypt. It was in this town Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James, and John to leave their nets and become fishers of men. Here, Jesus ate with sinners and called Matthew the tax collector to be an apostle. It was in Capernaum that Jesus healed the centurion's servant, Jairus' daughter, a nobleman's son, and Peter's mother-in-law. Here Jesus was accused of breaking the Sabbath and challenged the Pharisees notions of holiness. This city holds stories of Jesus' friends, enemies, miracles, and the fulfillment of prophecy.

This trip is limited to one bus of 48 guests. We will have a private guide throughout the trip with additional teaching from Denver Seminary professor Dr. Knut Heim and President Dr. Mark Young.
