RESPONSIBILITIES

This position reports to the Senior Pastor. Duties include:

- Recruit, train and develop teams of Sunday school teachers and volunteers
- Provide direction and support to teachers and volunteers on a weekly basis and keep them motivated
- Select and modify curriculum for classes
- Prepare weekly Sunday School materials (Crafts, games, handouts, lesson plans and discussion questions)
- Organize annual events (i.e. Mission's Month, VBS, etc.)
- Take necessary steps to provide for the safety and security of our kids

- Help prepare the annual Children’s Ministry budget in conjunction with the Kids Ministry Team
- Perform other duties as best fits the needs of the Children’s Ministry Director

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

1. *Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;*
2. *This training is for the benefit of the trainee;*
3. *Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;*
4. *This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;*
5. *Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;*
6. *Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.*
