INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY: Worship Intern

LOCATION: South Fellowship

POSITION SUMMARY: This person is responsible to assist the Worship Pastor in planning and leading various worship services of South Fellowship Church.

CHARACTER PROFILE:

Grow as a follower of Christ and as a result leader of others.

Develop leaders who advance the kingdom of God wherever they are.

This role is a part of our leadership development for the worship needs of South as we grow and church plant in the future. Interns are not assumed to be a part of future leadership of South Fellowship but they are intentionally being developed for that potential.

ESTIMATED TIME COMMITMENT: 10 hours per week

DUTIES:

- Lead musical worship at our Summit Young Adult ministry each week.
- Assist the Worship Pastor in musical worship leading in our Sunday services (primarily our 3rd service).
- Occasionally be the primary leader for Sunday services.
- Build a solid band consisting of core members and substitutes for the Summit Ministry. Develop & train band team members, bettering them as musicians, and mentor some who are capable of substituting as leaders in your absence to eventual be a leader.
- Hold regularly-scheduled rehearsals for Summit and other services if needed.
- Recruit, audition and train musicians and vocalists for Summit.
- Work under the Summit leadership to design liturgy for that weekly gathering.
- Schedule and oversee Summit tech and music team.
- Attend staff meetings and other planning meetings as needed.
- Pursue areas of personal and spiritual growth (e.g. spend time with the Lord daily as part of your devotional life, exercise spiritual disciplines, read books, attend the occasional seminar / conference, participate in a small group, and exercise physically)
- Meet regularly with the worship pastor and Summit Director
- Understand, internalize, and propagate the vision of South Fellowship Church
- Prepare for and assist in the strategy of our church planting efforts

- Proficiency in guitar/piano & vocals
- 1+ years experience leading others musically (band direction)
- Seminary or Bible College education preferred
- Able to lead people into a worshipful encounter with the living God.
- Knowledgeable about different genres of worship music: modern, contemporary, and traditional.
- Comfortable on stage in front of 300+ people
- Able to recruit and train volunteers musicians.

 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
