LOCATION: South Fellowship

POSITION SUMMARY: To see students belonging to South Fellowship Church and becoming disciples of Jesus through Gospel Transformation, Life-Giving Community, and Visible Faith.

- Be responsible for communication or finding replacements in lieu of absence.
- Organize and help create opportunities for volunteers to grow and develop.
- Work with volunteers to plan and execute The Summit evening gatherings.
- Strategize and develop plans with the leadership team to reach young adults.
- Work with South Fellowship master schedule to develop programing that directs Young Adults to Sunday services.
- Meet with 2-3 key volunteers to help develop the culture of leadership and development
- Check in consistently with team to ensure that our connection groups and service efforts are moving forward.
- Attend and co-oversee weekly gathering and a connection group.

- A growing relationship with Jesus Christ
- · Ability to lead and interact with students intentionally and effectively
- Ability to recruit and develop new leaders
- Love for South Fellowship young adults and the local church
- A commitment to studying God's Word and talking and listening to Him

- Exemplify servant leadership

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
