EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. The resident will participate for a one year program and this plan would allow the church and/or the resident to choose to renew or not to renew the agreement annually.
- 2. The resident must be an actively enrolled student in good academic standing in a degree program at Denver Seminary for all of his/her residency.
- 3. The resident will be expected to stand in full agreement with the church's doctrinal belief statement, and to live and serve according to the standards expected of ministry staff at HCC.
- 4. While allowances will be made for the student's schedule of classes and studies, he/she will be expected to participate in scheduled staff and department meetings as well as weekend services and events as required by his/her ministry area.
- 6. Residents should not anticipate being hired at the conclusion of their residencies, but should view this experience as an educational stepping-stone to further ministry.

DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
 This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
 - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
