

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

Community Outreach

1. Oversee and lead the Community Outreach Team in Boulder.
2. Connect and develop ongoing partnerships with four to five community outreach opportunities in our community.
3. Plan and manage community outreach events for the Erie Campus.
4. Build, develop and implement strategic opportunities for LifeGroups, family ministries and student ministries to contribute in significant ways with our community partners.
5. Serve as the point person for the 6:8 project at the Boulder Campus.
6. Establish departmental goals and objectives for community outreach in Boulder and evaluate progress.

Pastoral Ministry

1. Assist in the regular teaching and preaching as the senior pastor assigns
2. Assist in the community in congregational care by ministry to the needs of the body through counseling, hospital visits, funerals and weddings.

Expectations:

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DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:

 2. *This training is for the benefit of the trainee;*
3. *Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;*
4. *This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;*
5. *Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;*
6. *Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.*
