- Helping prepare and lead Tuesday night Middle School Services
- Teach multiple times each semester on Tuesday nights
- Regular participation in Ascent (5th/6th grade ministry) on Sunday morning to help bridge gap between Ascent and Student Ministries.
- Praying for each student and their families on a consistent basis.

- Engages in consistent prayer and growth in biblical understanding;
- Has experience working with middle school or high school students;
- Desire to invest in the 7th/8th grade students, inside and outside the church;
- Willingness to create high energy events for 7th/8th grade students;

- 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee; 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation; 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
 - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
 - 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
