POSITION SUMMARY: Green Mountain Christian Church is an established congregation in Lakewood, and we are looking for someone to commit to leading our worship services each week. The person who fills this position will work closely with the pastor, pastoral intern, and leadership in developing and arranging the song service each week. This includes the selection of music and the recruitment of other musicians, the developing of the content of the service with consideration of the topic or passage being preached, and the shepherding of the congregation through music, prayer, and scripture reading.

Primary Responsibilities & Tasks

- Weekly assist the Pastor in all planning and preparation for Sunday morning worship services including, but not limited to scheduling volunteers, selecting songs, writing chord charts, setting up the stage and sound board, printing and organizing music, creating Proclaim playlists.
- Lead Sunday morning worship services
- Conceptualize, organize, and execute special events in conjunction with the Pastor (e.g., nights of worship, Christmas Eve service, weddings, funerals, etc.)
- Conceptualize and incorporate creative arts into our worship services and worship space
- Learn about leadership within the context of church ministry

This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer; 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program; 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
