OverDrive eBooks can be found in the Carey S. Thomas Library by choosing “Search All Resources”. Click on “View eBook” to see options for accessing an eBook. DenverSeminary.overdrive.com also provides access. Click on the “Borrow” link.

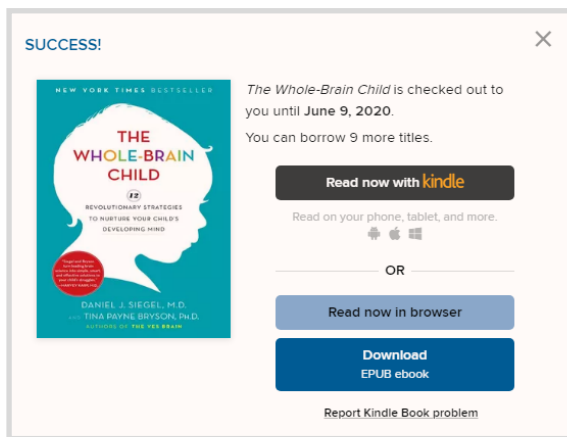

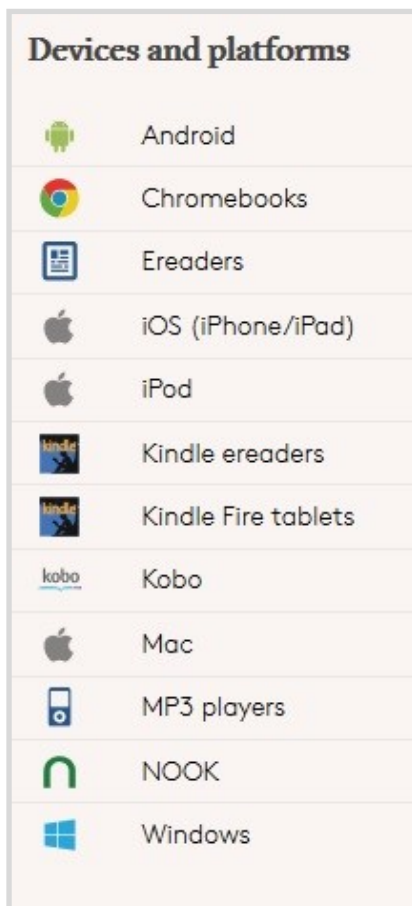

Choose the format you prefer.

1. Kindle will take you to Amazon.com. Sign into your Amazon account. Choose “Get Library Book”. Select the Kindle or Kindle app on which you want to read. Click “Download Now”. Turn on your Kindle. Connect to internet, and the book will download.
2. Browser format will open the book immediately. You will need to be connected to the internet to read it. This format includes a dyslexic font and the ability to change contrast and font size.
3. EPUB requires free Adobe Digital Editions software which you can download from <https://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions.html>.
