## **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

We currently are seeking a part-time Director of Children and Family Ministries. The Director of Children and Family Ministries provides leadership for our ministry with children and their families to assist them to come to know and grow in their relationship with God through Jesus Christ. This individual will work with the Head of Staff, other staff, and the children's discipleship team to carry out the vision of St. James Presbyterian Church as it relates to children's ministries.

- Oversee all aspects of our children's ministries
- Work with our volunteer leadership team to minister to the needs of our children (birth-5th grade), and work with youth leaders to help transition students into youth ministries
- Recruit, train and oversee additional volunteer leaders
- Develop and determine curriculum needs for children's ministries
- Build relationships between our parents, children, preschool and congregation
- Supervisor of the child care coordinator, MOPS Coordinator and ministry
- Develop and manage children's ministries budget
- Be a physical presence at church-wide events
- Other tasks, as directed
- Reports to the Head of Staff
- Meets with St. James staff for team building, ongoing training, and planning

## **DEFINITION OF THE MINISTRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM:**

By Definition the Residency Program is an Internship and contains the following:

- 1. Similar ministry training as that available in and through schooling for future clergy;
  - 2. This training is for the benefit of the trainee;
- 3. Resident is not a replacement for a regular employee, but works under close observation;
  - 4. This program is considered to be of greater value to the trainee than to the employer;
    - 5. Trainees are not necessarily entitled to a job at the completion of the program;
- 6. Employer and trainee understand that trainees are not entitled to wages for the time spent in training.
